ROOM PARENT

One of the key roles in the VCES VALOR Network is the room parent. Each grade will have two parents selected to serve as room parents for the entire year (one for each classroom). Room parents are selected by administration and teachers.

Areas that Room Parents Support:

- Support the teacher and his/her assistant with any classroom activity that requires parent participation and therefore should stay in close contact with the teacher via e-mail.
- Are responsible for coordinating the donations for Gala-silent auction baskets and grade projects.
- Volunteer for and coordinate two classroom parties per year.
- Send correspondence via e-mail, with teacher permission, to parents regarding special events in the classroom and school.
- Help recruit volunteers for classroom and VCES VALOR Network activities throughout the school year.
