## New Calendar Events – Q & A

### What are Fireside Events?

Fireside events are designed to bring our traditional community building activities, previously offered at outdoor school, onto campus. The Fireside Events will include collaboration with VCHS high school counselors who will help lead the students in team-building activities. Students, VCHS counselors, and all VCMS staff members will spend the afternoon and evening together, have a barbeque, enjoy campfire skits, songs and S'mores. The Fireside Events will occur rain or shine. The first three events are grade specific – to set time to develop community within each grade level. The last Fireside Event is open to all grades, to help build community across the grade levels. There will be four Fireside Events in the fall and our hope is to repeat the Fireside Events in the spring.

### What are Extend Day Field Trips?

Historically, there has been one day field trip, for each grade level, when the entire staff spends the day with one grade and the other two grades had the day off school. The purpose was to build community with all teachers and students, not just those teach that particular grade. As our staff and student body has grown, we want to make sure that all students and staff have the opportunity to engage in curriculum rich field trips that also focus on building our school community. We have found a way to rotate staff between the grade levels so that once a month, two grades will have the opportunity to participate in extend day field trips (allowing us to visit locations previously not feasible because of the distance) while one group of students work on asynchronous coursework. This means that over the course of three months, each grade will attend two extended field trips and have one asynchronous learning day. While we are still finalizing trips, plans include trips to Newport and the Hatfield Marine Science Center, Mount St. Helens Visitor Center or Mt. Hood Lava Beds, Tide pools in the North Oregon Coast, Sandy River Delta including the Damn, fish ladder, Hiking Forest Park, etc. Bottom line, we feel it is important to invest in the time to build community between students, and between the students and staff members while also exposing the students to the rich outdoor opportunities that the Pacific Northwest offers. The purposeful effort to incorporate more outdoor education is a goal for our program moving forward, both on campus and off, and the extend day field trips is part of the curriculum rich outdoor education we are incorporating into our program for all grade levels.
