Freshman Scholarship Application Requirements 2023-2024

Academic Scholarship

To apply for the ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP, you must submit:

1. A letter of recommendation from a teacher addressing the student's accomplishments and industry.
2. An essay on a book, person, experience, or activity that has been very important to you.

Fine Arts Scholarship

To apply for the FINE ARTS SCHOLARSHIP, you must submit:

1. A letter of recommendation from a fine arts teacher or mentor.
2. A list of fine arts experiences (in music, drama, visual art, or other).
3. Audition and/or portfolio submission.

A) For music and drama applicants: auditions will be held on a Saturday morning at the end of January or in early February. Our fine arts department and admissions office will reach out to applicants requiring an audition to notify you of your audition time slot and provide additional information about the audition process.

B) For visual art applicants: you may submit a portfolio of work, up to 6 pieces, at the front office of the high school by January 13th.
